Directions for Electronic Submission of OFA Applications & Radiographs

- ***Email address must be unique to your clinic and must be able to receive correspondence. If there is a problem with a submission, the OFA will reply to the sending email address to communicate the issue. OFA cannot accept submissions from a generic email address such as DoNotReply@idexx.com.**
- Digital images, whether on a CD or via email, are only accepted directly from the attending veterinary clinic. **OFA does not accept digital x-rays from owners.**
- Emailed radiographs must come as an attachment to the email. **Due to security issues, ZIP files are not accepted and will not be opened.** OFA does not accept links through Antech, View Cloud or other imaging services.
- All digital radiographs submitted must include dog identification (full registered name, if applicable, OR registration number OR microchip number/tattoo), clinic name and date of radiography overlaid on image.
- For emailed submissions the OFA application may either be scanned and included in the email along with image (preferred), or it may be faxed to 573-875-5073. To facilitate matching, the application should arrive at approximately the same time as the emailed image(s). For CD submissions, please include the application and payment with the CD. This will ensure that your client's application is efficiently matched up with the correct images.
- Include credit card payment information (MasterCard or Visa ONLY) in the appropriate section of the application form. Required credit card information includes: cardholder name, card number, expiration date and 3-digit security code. For more accurate billing if there are credit card issues, please indicate whether this is an owner payment or a veterinary clinic payment. If your clinic would like to keep a credit card on file with the OFA office, please contact Carol Skinner at 573-442-0418 x221.
- If multiple applications are submitted in a single email, make sure each file is uniquely and appropriately named.
